HERE'S HOW TO REQUEST YOUR BALLOT BEFORE ELECTION DAY

Want to skip the long line of election day and vote in an easy, convenient method? Then follow the simple steps below:

- Check Your Registration Status: Ensure your voter registration information is up to date at prodvoterportal.mt.gov/WhereToVote.aspx so you won't have any issues.
- 2. Apply for Your Ballot: By mail or in person at your county election board or other designated location.
- Track Your Ballot Status: You can sign up to track your mail ballot on the Montana Secretary of State website: prodvoterportal.mt.gov/WhereToVote.aspx
- 4. **Return Your Ballot:** Ballots are mailed 25 days before election day. For mail ballots, simply follow the information on the form and submit it accordingly. Or vote in-person at your county election board or other designated location.
- 5. Verify Your Ballot: Once you have submitted your ballot, verify on the state website that it has been fully processed!

THEN YOU ARE DONE FOR THE CYCLE AND THOSE ANNOYING CALLS WILL STOP!

THINGS TO KNOW:

- ✓ You can request your absentee ballot today!
- ✓ You no longer need an excuse to vote by mail
- ✓ Want to vote early in person? Simply visit your county election board or other designated location, which may make ballots available starting 30 days before Election Day!
- Absentee and Mail-in Ballots must be received by 8 p.m. on Election Day at your county election board.
